Prayer

How do you take many many things to prayer?

How much are we limiting ourselves to safe prayers?

How do I know when God has said No to a request?

Do all prayers carry the same weight?

GOD HAS CHOSEN TO WORK THROUGH HUMANITY TO HAVE HIS KINGDOM COME. PRAYER IS WHAT CHANGES OUR WORLD

Overcoming the distractions of everyday life. Just finding time to set aside to spend with God.

How do we know if we should push on with prayer? What if its not in God's will?

Why is it that some people's prayers are answered and others aren't?

Should we continue to say we are desperate? THE LORD IS ON OUR SIDE–WE MUST HAVE COMPLETE CONFIDENCE IN HIM.

Should all our prayer/warfare be Bible based?

Why do I have difficulty with praying but find it easier when not trying?

How do I keep the faith when prayers aren't answered in the way I want?

How can we know God's will in specific situations?

I HAVE WITNESSED GOD MOVING IN MY LIFE AND WORKING MORE VIVIDLY AS I HAVE PRAYED TO DELIGHT MORE IN HIM.

Is God telling me to spend more time praying or am I on a self-inflicted guilt trip?

I FIND PRAYER CAN BE VERY SOOTHING OR A REAL CHALLENGE.

When you run out of words and praying in the spirit, how do you pray?

WE MAY PRAY WITH GREAT FAITH AND EXPECTATION BUT EVEN AS WITH CHRIST'S JOURNEY IT IS, 'GOD'S WILL BE DONE'.

How many times is it necessary to pray for one thing? Is it us that may not have enough patience.

How can I increase my expectations?

Am I only allowed to pray once a day?

If it is God's will to do something anyway, why pray?

If you pray for the same thing repetitively, is it better or worse than praying once for that thing?

PRAYER IS PIERCING THE DARKNESS OF AN OVERCAST WORLD TO LET THE LIGHT OF THE LAMB SHINE THROUGH–The city does not need the sun or the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and the Lamb is its lamp. Revelation 21:23

Is it better to pray repeatedly for the same thing or just once?

If you pray for repentance for something in your head, is that enough?

Fasting

Planned on fasting but turned into spiritual warfare. Why?

What would a 40 day fast result in compared to a 3 day one?

What does fasting do to get prayer answered or does it?

Surprisingly difficult to find something to fast. Already skipping meals for other reasons.

Can we each be held accountable for God not doing things because we did not pray enough or fast enough? If we take these to the ultimate, there is no life.

OTHER DISCIPLINES. 'FIRST FRUITS'-WHEN I START THE DAY <u>FIRST THING</u> WITH PRAYER, BIBLE DEVOTIONAL READING, THE DAY SEEMS TO WORK BETTER AND ABLE TO PEACEFULLY DEAL WITH DISASTER CALAMITY ETC.

I fast. I want to diet. Is it right/fair that it kills two birds with one stone?

How long should you fast for?

Does fasting mean not eating?

How do you survive fasting?

What is the essence of token fasting? Is not the fast that God wants for us: to do his will, to take care of the widow, the orphan, the hopeless, hungry etc.

Warfare

Has Dayspring opened its eyes to what is happening around us in regard to spiritual attack and the required response?

Are we fighting something tangible or not?

WHETHER WE LIKE IT OR NOT WE ARE ALL INVOLVED IN SPIRITUAL WARFARE

GOD HAS NOT GIVEN US A SPIRIT OF FEAR BUT OF POWER AND LOVE AND A SOUND MIND. WHEN IN THE MIDDLE OF STUFF, WE HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO CAST OUT DEMONS THEN AND THERE AND DO NOT HAVE TO WAIT FOR A PRAYER TEAM OR HEALING MINISTRY TO COME TO THE RESCUE.

Do we need others' eyes to see our own spiritual warfare?

How do we identify our adversary?

We are told to hold the sword of faith to quench attacks from the enemy but I sometimes find it hard to know how to put this into practice.

How does a church actively and effectively change the effect of any spiritual forces that seem to influence an area?

Is there a link between praying for finance and a poverty spirit over Wiltshire?

What is the way to jump the s-curve (eg messy church or bus) and how to avoid the early stage chasm?

Having had personal experiences of deliverance, when is it appropriate to share these?

What about the full armour of God? Is it invincible if we employ it properly? Can we get better at using it to stand firm against the devil's schemes.

THERE ARE ALWAYS CASUALTIES IN WARFARE BUT I HAVE NO CONCERNS AS THIS VICTORY WAS SECURED AT THE CROSS?

APART FROM THE SWORD, ALL THE OTHER ITEMS MENTIONED ARE DEFENSIVE.

Bad things happen, so when is it spiritual warfare and does it need a title?

How does spiritual warfare manifest itself in the physical world–e.g. is a cold ever demonic? Where do you draw the line?

How do you know when an issue is particularly needing to be approached as spiritual warfare?

How do I deal with spiritual warfare with children?

What is normal life and what is warfare? Why do some people confuse them?
