Bitterness

- 1. Physical sense of taste
- 2. Sense of cruel, biting words; intense misery from forsaking God, from a life of sin & impurity, the misery of servitude, the misfortunes of bereavement
- 3. Bitter & bitterness describe emotions of sympathy, the sorrow of childlessness and of penitence, of disappointment, the feeling of misery & wretchedness, giving rise to "bitter tears"
